







#### LIBRARY

We have a vast & well furnished rich library having more than 15000 books. The librarian takes concerted effort to collect all the question papers of University Examinations of previous years and compiles them in right order. College Library provides access to all reference collections including encyclopedias, yearbooks, dictionaries, atlas, biographies, competition books and reports etc. There are 2500 books available in the book bank for the needful students free of charge.

#### **CHEMISTRY LAB**

Chemistry is, of course, a practical subject and so strong emphasis on the acquisition of laboratory skills is highly required. The College has a well equipped lab to enhance the experimental skills of the students



#### **PHYSICS LAB**

The lab is airy, well-lit and has ample space for storing the instruments used in Physics Practicals. The stabilized power supply is provided in the lab. Sufficient number of electrical boards and switches are available in the lab for performing electrical, electronics and optics experiments. Physics lab is well equipped with sufficient number of modern instruments which are required for upgrading the skills of students

#### **ZOOLOGY LAB**

Zoology LAB is well equipped with preserved specimen, Bio- visual charts, Models, Slides, Microscopes, Haemocytometer, Hemoglobinometer, PH Meter, Centrifuge etc. Some important practicals covered during the session are dissection of animals, permanent slide preparation, cytological experiment, study of bones, estimation of hemoglobin, measurement of blood pressure and heart beat and study of histological slides





#### **BOTANY LAB**

The College has a well-established laboratory of Botany with all facilities. The Department of Botany is working to equip the students with skill based expertise and technical knowledge in the field.

#### **GEOGRAPHY LAB**

The lab is well equipped with a series of maps, topographic sheets and variety of survey equipments like tracing table, thermometers, barometer, magnetic compass, indicator and wet and dry bulb thermometers. Field trips are organized for the students to study the climate and vegetation of the nearby areas.



#### **HOME SCIENCE LAB**

We have different sections in the lab for different activities like, cooking, stitching, embroidery, knitting and home management.

This lab is fully equipped with a cooking range, microwave, refrigerator, hot plates and all other required equipments. The experienced teacher gives students training and guidance in the fields of food & nutrition, clothing & textile and home management. Field trips are organized where students give knowledge about health and hygiene to the villagers

#### **COMPUTER LAB**

The entire college is networked and the services provided are linked and monitored electronically by an expert technical team.

The Computer Lab is fully equipped with latest machines and Internet facility to arouse the interest of the students.
