- New session of college will commence as per guidelines of College Education Department, Rajasthan

# Amenities

## LIBRARY

We have a vast & well furnished rich library having more than 15000 books. The librarian takes concerted effort to collect all the question papers of University Examinations of previous years and compiles them in right order. ## CHEMISTRY LAB

## PHYSICS LAB

Sufficient number of electrical boards and switches are available in the lab for performing electrical, electronics and optics experiments. Physics lab is well equipped with sufficient number of modern instruments which are required for upgrading the skills of students



## ZOOLOGY LAB

Zoology lab is well equipped with preserved specimen, Bio- visual charts, Models, Slides, Microscopes, Haemocytometer, Hemoglobinometer, PH Meter, Centrifuge etc. Some important practicals covered during the session are dissection of animals, permanent slide preparation, cytological experiment, study of bones, estimation of hemoglobin, measurement of blood pressure and heart beat and study of histological slides



# BOTANY LAB

The College has a well-established laboratory of Botany with all facilities. The Department of Botany is working to equip the students with skill based expertise and technical knowledge in the field.



# GEOGRAPHY LAB

The lab is well equipped with a series of maps, topographic sheets and variety of survey equipments like tracing table, thermometers, barometer, magnetic compass, indicator and wet and dry bulb thermometers. Field trips are organized for the students to study the climate and vegetation of the nearby areas.

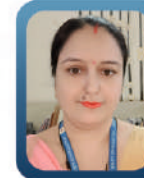
